TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

- Conducts daily inspection of buildings, machinery and equipment and reports any deficiencies to supervisor;
- Does preventive maintenance and makes needed repairs on a wide variety of equipment and machinery such as pumps, mechanical bar screens, blowers, conveyors, filter, hydraulic presses, pneumatic equipment, generators, electrical wiring systems, plumbing and piping systems and electrical systems;
- Fabricates material for repair of machines and equipment, involving grinding, welding, (gas and electric) and acetylene cutting;
- Performs needed carpentry, painting and maintenance work as needed at the Wastewater Treatment Plant;
- When assigned, installs, calibrates and maintains wastewater sampling devices at industrial facilities;
- May operate automotive equipment when assigned;
- Performs general repairs and maintenance of plant vehicles;

The above examples of duties are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school, possession of a high school equivalency diploma, or a high school individual education plan diploma, and either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an associate degree in mechanical technology, electrical technology or other technical field; or
- (B) Two years of experience in the maintenance and repair of mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic, or electrical equipment; or
- (C) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B) above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State Operator's license for the vehicles operated.
