PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Siarkowski opened a public hearing at 7:00 P.M. on proposed 2019-2020 sewer rates.

No one was present to speak in favor, or in opposition, of the proposed 2019-2020 sewer rates. Chairman Siarkowski closed the public hearing at 7:10 P.M.

On a motion made by Ms. Martin, seconded by Mr. Vose, carried six (6) in favor, and none (0) opposed, the Board adopted the 2019-2020 sewer rates, effective May 1, 2019 as follows:
